### LOT 1044

A pair of Chinese export porcelain plates, Qianlong period, each painted en grisaille and gilt with flowers, vase and Buddha's hand citron, diameters 22.8cm (some faults), together with an en grisaille decorated sparrow beak cream jug, height 11.3cm, and a similarly decorated teabowl, diameter 7.4cm (cracks).

### Condition Report

1044. Plate 1 - star crack across the whole of the base, visible from front and back. Otherwise plate has no chips or repairs. Some wear to gilt and en grisaille decoration. Typical light surface scratches.

Plate 2 - 4cm hairline to rim and two small rim chips, otherwise typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze, gilt and decoration.

Teabowl - 2cm hairline to rim, few minor nicks to rim, typical light surface scratches to glaze and wear to decoration and gilt.

Jug - crack to handle, no cover, typical surface scratches and wear to gilt and enamels.
