A Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain vase, mid to late 19th century, the ovoid body and flared neck painted with figural scenes, reserved against a bird and flower ground, applied chilong to shoulders and Buddhist lion cub handles, height 35.5cm (later converted to a table lamp).

Condition Report

1032. The vase is in generally good condition but it does have a light fitting stuck into its neck which would need to be carefully removed. No drill holes. Typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze and enamels. Some wear to gilt particularly on rim. A bit dirty and dusty so would benefit from a clean.
