A small group of Chinese famille rose export porcelain teaware, 18th century and later, comprising a teabowl, painted with precious objects, height 4cm (minor hairline), a small teabowl, painted with opposing figural panels, height 3.7cm, another teabowl, painted with ducks and lotus, height 3.5cm, and three matching saucers/stands, diameters 7cm (hairlines).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

1029. 18th century famille rose teabowl - 2xm hairline to rim, otherwise ok with no chips or restoration. Typical minor wear to enamels.

Famille rose teabowl - 0.4cm hairline to rim, otherwise good condition.

Duck and Lotus teabowl - 1.8cm hairline to rim, otherwise ok.

3 matching saucers - one with small hairline to rim, others in good condition.

All with typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels.
