A Chinese two-tone agate libation cup, 19th/20th century, the white stone cup formed as a lotus leaf within a cagework of iron red lotus flowers, leaves and scrolling stems, length 13.5cm (minor chips), with carved green stained rockwork stand (minor chips and losses).

Provenance: from the estate of the late Nigel Pollitzer, adopted son of multimillionaire George Pollitzer and his wife Esme and former friend of Sarah, Duchess of York.

### Condition Report

1140. The agate cup has numerous small chips and nicks to rim, flowers and stems, but no significant damage or repairs. Some surface scratches and wear.

The stand has a couple of small chips to one side, some typical surface scratches and wear to staining.
