A small group of Asian art, mostly 19th century, including a Chinese blue and white small circular dish, mark of Chenghua but later, painted with a blossoming prunus, diameter 14cm, a Canton enamel circular box and cover, mark of Qianlong but 20th century, painted with a seated female flautist, diameter 5.5cm, and an Indian bronze figure of Shiva Nataraj dancing on Apasmara Purusha, height 19.7cm.

Condition Report

1113. Blue and white circular dish - in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches to glaze, but nothing of any real significance.

Enamel box and cover - generally good condition. Typical light surface scratches and some surface wear. A little dirty so would benefit from a clean. No significant damage or repairs.

Indian bronze - good condition, no significant damage or repairs.

Mudmen figure - generally good condition, few minor chips.

Two Japanese small bowls - good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear.

Iron red bowl - good condition, but wear to gilt.
