### Condition Report

1110. Generally good condition. Faint 0.6cm hairline to rim of saucer, otherwise all 3 pieces are in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches to glaze and enamels, minor wear to gilt but overall good bright and vibrant decoration.
