A Chinese sang-de-boeuf glazed porcelain bottle vase, early 20th century, the globular body and cylindrical narrow neck covered in a speckled oxblood glaze, unmarked, height 35cm (bruise to rim), together with a hardwood stand.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1105. Generally good condition. Small bruise to rim with small hairlines emanating from this area and running approx 3cm around the rim and approx 2.5cm down from the rim. Otherwise no other significant damage or repairs. small chip to footrim. Typical surface scratches to glaze and some crazing to the glaze, most obviously noticeable in the neck. Good rich glaze.

Wood stand with natural shrinkage crack and some minor chips.
