A Chinese agate snuff bottle, probably late Qing dynasty, of flattened shouldered rectangular form, the pale grey stone with russet streaks, height 5.5cm, with stopper, together with another agate snuff bottle of flattened circular form, carved in low relief with mask handles, height 6cm, with stopper.

Condition Report

1026. Both agate snuff bottles in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches.

Larger bottle's stopper has not fittings (i.e. spoon or securing cork).
