Two Chinese blue and white export porcelain square tiles, Kangxi period, each painted with lotus within scrolling tendril borders, 20.2cm x 20.2cm and 20.5cm x 20.5cm (both chipped). Provenance: from the private collection of David Armitage, former conservator to the Department of Eastern Art at the Ashmolean Museum, Oxford, between 1970 and 1999.

Condition Report

1048. Tile 1 - darker underglaze blue with large chip to one corner, few other minor nicks/chips. Typical surface scratches and wear to glaze. No cracks or restoration.

Tile 2 - more vibrant blue decoration with large chip to one corner. Otherwise, numerous minor chips to edges, some pitting to glaze and typical surface scratches and wear to glaze.
