A group of Chinese blue and white porcelain, 18th century and later, including a pair of export porcelain side plates, Qianlong period, painted with flowers, diameter 16.2cm and an export porcelain plate, Qianlong period, painted with pine and fence, diameter 23cm, together with two celadon glazed bowls, diameters 13cm and 13.5cm, and a Canton famille rose bowl, diameter 15cm (some faults).

Condition Report

1219. Pair of small blue and white export plates - one with shallow rim chip and glaze fritting to rim, otherwise ok. The other with typical glaze fritting to rim, otherwise ok. Both with typical surface scratches and wear to glazed.

Export plate - 5.5cm hairline to rim and typical glaze fritting to rim.

Celadon bowl - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Few minor nicks to footrim.

Shallow celadon bowl - generally good condition, minor nicks to rim and footrim.

Canton famille rose bowl - hairline crack to rim, otherwise ok.

Blue and white bowl - good condition.

Blue and white teabowl - 2.5cm hairline to rim, otherwise good condition.

Blue and white ginger jar - small hairline to rim and cover with small hairline to rim.

Blue and white baluster vase - small hairline to rim, otherwise ok.

Small blue and white ginger jar - good condition.

Small box - crack to rim.

Larger blue and white cover - broken in half and reglued.

7.5cm diameter blue and white cover - good condition.

2 blue and white covers - both damaged.
