### LOT 1209

A collection of Chinese and Japanese pottery, late 19th century and later, including a Chinese famille verte crackle glazed cylinder vase, height 29.4cm, a Chinese famille verte relief moulded bottle vase, decorated with figures, height 22cm, a Chinese blanc-de-Chine Buddha, height 15.5cm, a Japanese Satsuma earthenware vase and various Kutani vases (some faults).

Estimate: £50 - £100

### Condition Report

1209. Famille verte cylinder vase - generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light crazing to glaze. 4cm firing crack to rim.

Famille verte moulded vase - generally good condition, typical surface scratches and wear to decoration.

Satsuma vase - badly broken and glued back together with typical wear to gilt.

Buddha - repaired and restored right hand, but needs attention as paint has gone off (creamy colour). Chip to lower edge of robe, otherwise ok.

Blue and white ginger jar - cover repaired, otherwise ok, typical surface scratches to glaze.

Small Chinese iron red decorated vase - good condition, typical minor wear to gilt.

Imari gourd vase - ok, typical wear and scratches, some crazing to upper neck.

Imari plate - chip to rim and typical surface scratches and wear.

Two famille rose ginger jars - good condition but both covers repaired.

Pair of ruby ground ginger jars - good condition.

Small ginger jar - good condition.

Black ground vase - good condition.

2 taller Kutani vases - both with restored necks.

Pair of smaller Kutani vases - one with rim chip, both with typical wear.

Single Kutani vase - good condition with typical wear.
