A pair of Middle Eastern gold, diamond, ruby and jade earrings, each mounted with a carved and pierced central jade, otherwise mounted with three circular cut diamonds, four circular cut rubies and two circular cut emeralds, with post and folding fittings, unmarked, weight 18.9g, length 3.2cm.

Estimate: £600 - £900

Condition Report

In generally good condition overall.

One claw supporting one emerald is lacking, requires re-tipping.

Rubies and emeralds are fairly included stones.

Diamonds are fairly white stones, clarity S12/I1 on average.

Jades look to be in good condition, no cracks evident.

The earrings are unmarked. The metal likely gold, has not been tested.
