### LOT 690

An Edwardian 18ct gold and diamond ring, designed as two entwined snakes, Chester 1901, weight 8.6g, ring size approx U1/2 (one diamond lacking).

Estimate: £300 - £400

### Condition Report

Some thinning to the shank, typical scratching/scuffing overall.

The ring has been resized with an additional piece of gold added in on one side.

The larger remaining diamond is rose cut and fairly shallow. Face up looks approx 0.50ct, more likely 0.35ct ish.

Measures 5mm x 4mm approx. - pear shaped.

Total diamond weight approx 0.40-0.50ct.

The diamonds set to the eyes are diamond chips.

The second larger diamond lacking.
