### LOT 740

A late Victorian gold, silver set, ruby and diamond crescent brooch, mounted with a row of graduated oval cut and cushion shaped rubies and graduated cushion shaped and rose cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 9.7g, width 3.8cm.

Estimate: £700 - £900

### Condition Report

Due to the setting, it is difficult to be accurate with a total carat weight of rubies - we would suggest 2.50-3.00ct. Largest ruby approx. 5.3mm x 4.3mm x 2.6mm.

The rubies are well matched for colour and have a few inclusions when viewed under a lens. A few can be seen with the naked eye.

Diamonds generally - clarity SI, one or two have surface chips. Colour approx J/K. (gradings are estimations, limited by the setting and for guidance only).

Largest diamond approx 2.7mm diameter. Total diamond weight approx 0.60-0.70ct.

The pin and fastening is in working order.

Some overall tarnishing.

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
