An 18th century oak and yew provincial lowboy, the shaped top inlaid with a star above two frieze drawers and cabriole legs, height 73cm, width 76cm, depth 50cm (alterations).

Condition Report

2090. General condition is ok, with a scratched indentation to the front point of the star and some minor scuffs and marks. The yew legs appear to have been the legs of another table and married to the oak top and frieze, probably during the 19th century.
