## LOT 2163

A Regency mahogany triple-pillar dining table, the three-section top with two extra leaves, the shaped legs terminating in cast brass foliate caps, height 73cm, extended length 366cm, depth 122cm (alterations).

## Condition Report

2163. General condition and appearance of the table is reasonably good, with some overall minor surface scratches, a more substantial scratch across centre section, as well as a slightly gapping of timber to the centre section. The legs have the usual minor surface knocks and wear, and there are a few clips missing.

In terms of alterations throughout its life, it appears that whilst the top is possibly of the same period, the way it fits to the pedestals has been changed and there are old marks to the underside where clips and bars have been moved. There have been extra sliding supports added to the underside to hold the leaves in place. Some of the support bars are therefore later altered, but otherwise generally the table top seems to be original and structurally sound.
