1029. Generally good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear. Gaping between one link where pin is missing so needs attention. Dial in good clean order. Hour hand adjusts but minute hand is not adjusting. Date rolls over as it should and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Clasp a little tight but in working order. Bracelet length including closed clasp approx 14.5cm. Red box with broken hinge.
