LOT 1173

An early 19th century Welsh oak and mahogany longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 13-inch square painted dial with Roman hour numerals, date aperture and subsidiary seconds, inscribed 'Griffith Llanfyllin', the hood with swan neck pediment and glazed door, the trunk with rectangular door flanked by columns, on bracket feet, height 222.5cm, with pendulum and two weights.

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1173. The clock is in fairly good condition but does have some issues which would require attention. Case is generally ok but does have some historic signs of woodworm to top of hood and columns. Some slight lifting to veneer on hood and some splits/repairs to veneer on hood door. Small chip to bottom right corner of glass in hood. Small area of veneer missing to one bracket foot. Dial with typical wear. Movement is filthy and would require a service/overhaul to return to working condition. There is no winding key or crank, but is a standard size so would be easy to find a replacement.
