A late 19th century French ormolu cased mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the white enamelled dial with blue Roman hour and outer Arabic minute numerals, the drum case with a two bird and branch surmount above a pair of Cupid, swan, fish and floral swags, height 29cm, with pendulum.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1177. All of the elements of the clock case appear to be present, but there has been a repair to the right hand swag where it had broken.

Dial is a little dirty and missing glass to case back.

Movement does not wind or run.
