Condition Report

1215. The microscope appears to be in generally good condition. Typical surface scratches and wear to brass and black enamel. Rotatable turret appears to be in working order. All rack and pinion focusing are smooth and in good working order. There are 3 objective lenses.

Box in generally good order, typical scuffs, scratches and wear. Door closes tightly and locks.
