A silver hunting cased keywind gentleman's pocket watch, the unsigned gilt lever movement detailed 'M7873', the enamelled dial with Roman numerals, Chester 1887, case diameter 5cm, and a silver cased keywind open-faced pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with a lever escapement, detailed 'W.L.Miller AD1854 No 1535', London 1853, case diameter 4.7cm, with two keys and a case, together with a Waltham USA gilt metal cushion cased gentleman's wristwatch, case width 3cm, a gilt metal Borgel cased wristwatch, case diameter 3.4cm, three other gentlemen's gilt metal and steel backed wristwatches and a Camerer Cuss lady's wristwatch.
