A late 19th century French ormolu and white marble mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the white enameled dial with black Roman hour numerals, the case cast with a figure of Cupid, drum and other musical instruments, on a white marble base, height 26cm (lacking feet and bell and other faults).

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1178. The ormolu case is in generally good condition with no significant damage. It is a bit dusty and dirty, typical minor surface scratches and wear and missing whatever the Cupid was holding in both hands. Dial is cracked and chipped to edge.

White marble base is missing mounts and feet.

Missing bell and missing pendulum so unable to ascertain whether it runs or not, but It is all a bit dusty and dirty so would probably require a service/overhaul to get the movement back to full working order anyway.

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
