A George III silver pair cased gentleman's pocket watch, the keywind gilt fusee movement with verge escapement and pierced and engraved balance cock, the backplate signed 'Chas Johnson London 2722', the white enamelled dial painted with a scene of Adam and Eve standing either side of the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil, framed by black Roman hour and outer Arabic minute numerals, the outer case containing Dutch watch paper detailed 'A. Guise Hoorn', London 1783, outer case diameter 5.3cm, with a winding key.

Condition Report

1093. The watch winds smoothly but does not run, otherwise movement appears to be ok, if a little bit dusty. The dial has a small chip to edge at 1 o'clock and a hairline between 5 & 6 o'clock. Case with typical surface scratches and wear, small dent to back and a lead repair to hinge and stem. Bow slightly misshapen. Glass is good and front closes tightly. Outer case with matching hallmarks, typical surface scratches and wear, and numerous small dents to case back and sides. Closes tightly and button release working.

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
