A late Victorian oak cased mantel clock with eight day movement striking on two gongs, the backplate stamped 'W & H Sch' (Winterhalder & Hofmeier), the silvered rectangular dial with subsidiary pendulum regulation dial above Roman hour numerals and engraved foliate scroll corners, the case with carved top above fluted cut corner columns and bevelled glass panels, on a moulded rectangular plinth and gilt brass bun feet, height 27.5cm, with pendulum and winding key.

Condition Report

1189. The clock is in generally good condition. Case is nicely carved with only minor typical scuffs and scratches. Front and back doors are good. All glass panels in good order. Silvered dial with some wear and scratches. Both trains of movement wind smoothly and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The strike mechanism also works and strikes on the hours and quarters. The regulation dial is also working as it should.
