A Zenith Automatic Defy stainless steel octagonal cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa late 1960s, the signed grey dial with baton hour markers and date aperture between 4 and 5 o'clock, the case back detailed '614D847', case width 3.7cm, on a tapered link bracelet with foldover clasp. Provenance: purchased by the current vendor in 1969.

Condition Report

1065. The watch winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Date is not adjusting as it should. Scratches to case and glass/crystal heavily scratched. Winding button/crown screws into case tightly. Dial with a few dirt specks, but otherwise ok. Bracelet with scratches, clasp works as it should. Length of bracelet including clasp at present approx 15.5cm, with adjustment it could be made approx 1cm larger and approx 1.5cm smaller.

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
