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A platinum, aquamarine and diamond ring, circa 1940, claw set with a rectangular step cut aquamarine between diamond set shoulders, mounted with circular and single cut diamonds, numbered '2549', unmarked, weight 6.5g, aquamarine weight approx 6.20ct, ring size approx K1/2, with a case.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

Some overall abrasion to the facet edges of the aquamarine, one or two nicks amongst them. No significant chips. One or two needle like inclusions near one corner, noticeable when viewed under a 10x loupe. All diamonds are present, average clarity SI, average colour J/K (diamond gradings are estimations, limited by the setting and for guidance only)

Some noticeable thinning to the back of the shank and some slight wear to the sides of the setting.

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
