LOT 515

A gold, seed pearl, emerald and diamond bracelet, formed as eight rows of seed pearls with five emerald and diamond bar divisions at intervals, on a sliding clasp, unmarked, weight 14.6g, length 16.2cm.

Estimate: £300 - £400

Condition Report

In generally good condition overall.

The emeralds are an attractive rich green, though with typical inclusions, some dark in nature. Some inclusions are surface reaching.

The diamonds are single cut stones. One has a small chip to the table facet edge, another has a larger chip to the girdle.

Some wear to the surrounds supporting the emeralds and diamonds, all stones appear secure at present.

The pearls look to have minimal wear or peeling, with an attractive creamy/silvery lustre.

One strand of pearls has been slightly miss-threaded and doesn't pass through both sides of one of the divisions, instead runs below it on one side. This is not detrimental at present but may lead to the string rubbing over time.
