A Victorian gold backed, silver set, diamond and pearl brooch in a swirling design with a central pearl and diamond cluster, otherwise mounted with rose cut and cushion shaped diamonds, unmarked, weight 5.4g, width 2.2cm (pearl untested), with an associated case.

Estimate: £300 - £400

Condition Report

The pearl has a creamy lustre, with some slight imperfections to the surface.

The diamonds are on average, clarity SI, colour J-L. Four or five has chips noticeable when viewed under a microscope (diamond gradings are estimations, limited by the setting and for guidance only).

The pin/fastening are both in working order.

Some typical light wear to the mount. Currently all stones appear secure.
