An Art Deco platinum, aquamarine and diamond brooch of marquise form, mounted with an octagonal step cut aquamarine within a surround of rose and old cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 11.5g, aquamarine dimensions approx 18.3mm x 13.9mm x 8.6mm, width 4.2cm, with a case.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

In generally good condition overall.

Aquamarine has one or two needle-like inclusions and a tiny feather inclusion to the pavilion. Some slight abrasion to the facet edges, with a small scratch, largely only visible when using a loupe.

All diamonds present and appear secure.

Diamonds on average - clarity SI, colour I-K, the rose cut diamonds of the outer borders are looking a little grey and subdued (diamond gradings are estimations, limited by the setting and for guidance only).

Pin/hinge in working order. Both can be unscrewed and removed if required.

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
