Albert Ernest Carrier-Belleuse - 'Liseuse', a late 19th century French silvered and gilt bronze figure with ivory face and hands, finely cast as a full-length lady dressed in Renaissance costume, modelled reading from a book, the base bearing case signature and titled plaque, height 61.5cm. Note: a non-transferrable ivory exemption certificate has been granted for the sale of this item.

## **Condition Report**

2550. The figure has a slightly over-cleaned surface, leaving some areas a little over-polished. There are some spots of tarnish around the pedestal and this also has a dent to the lower edge. Two of the fingers on her right hand have been broken and glued back on. Otherwise in generally good order.
