An Art Deco platinum, aquamarine and diamond pendant, circa 1925, mounted with a marquise shaped aquamarine to the top and a cut cornered rectangular aquamarine to the drop, otherwise mounted with circular and baguette cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 7.5g, total aquamarine weight approx 6.25ct, total diamond weight approx 1.60-1.80ct, length 5.5cm, with a trace link neckchain on a cylindrical clasp, unmarked, weight 2.8g, length 37.5cm, with a Mappin & Webb case.

Estimate: £1,500 - £2,000

Condition Report

In generally good condition overall.

The aquamarine to the drop has a few needle-like inclusions. Measurements approx. 9.8mm x 7.4mm x 5.3mm. Sits slightly loose in its setting.

The marquise aquamarine has no obvious inclusions. Measurements approx. 20.1mm x 6.4mm x 4.8mm.

Diamonds all present and appear secure in their settings. Average clarity approx SI, colour approx I-J (diamond gradings are estimations, limited by the setting and for guidance only)

Pin and hinge in working order.

Neckchain in good condition, cylindrical clasp in working order.
