A white metal and diamond ring, claw set with a row of three principal old cut cushion shaped diamonds at the centre, otherwise in a twist design further mounted with diamonds, unmarked, weight 6.7g, total diamond weight 2.00ct, ring size approx M (shank split at shoulder, one diamond lacking), with a case.

Condition Report

Principal diamonds approx.

6.2mm x 5.8mm x 4mm,

5mm x 4.9mm x 3.15mm and,

5mm x 5mm x 3.2mm.

Average clarity approx VS2/SI1, colour I-K (centre stone appearing ever so slightly yellow compared to the other two). Ring is dirty, colour might improve once professional cleaned.

Claws in fairly good condition, some claws have been re-tipped in the past.

Split to one shoulder, with one small diamond lacking.

Typical scratching and scuffing to shank and setting.
