### Condition Report

2014. The rear legs have been tipped with the bottom 10cm replaced. The front legs have poor quality repair to the damage around rear edges of tips. Seat caning is a little loose, but generally in good order. Later screws holding castors on the front legs. Height to seat 37cm, excluding cushion.
