LOT 590

An 18ct white gold, sapphire and diamond five stone bar brooch, mounted with three cushion shaped sapphires alternating with two cushion shaped diamonds, detailed '18', as converted from a ring, weight 5.2g, total diamond weight approx 0.35-0.40ct, width 5.8cm, with an associated case.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

The piece is a ring converted into a bar brooch. The shank is the bar, the hallmark is now only partially visible/readable.

Some general scratching and abrasion to the sapphires facets and facet edges.

Three or four claws are showing signs of wear, particularly those supporting the diamonds. It would be advisable to have these re-tipped.

Diamonds approx colour H/I, approx clarity SI (diamond gradings are estimations, limited by the setting and for guidance only)

Pin, hinge and fastening all in good condition.

Largest sapphire approx 4.1mm x 4.1mm x 2.3mm

The associated case is too small to hold the piece securely.

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
