An Elizabeth II silver three-piece novelty condiment set, each in the form of an owl with feather detail and glass eyes, comprising a mustard with mouse finial spoon, a pepper caster and a salt caster, London 1971 by William Comyns & Sons Ltd, total weight 245.1g, height of mustard 7.3cm (one glass eye lacking).

Condition Report

360. All 3 pieces in generally good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear. Good crisp detail to plumage and all stand solidly and straight. Good clear hallmarks.

Mustard - hinge is good, some slight sideward play but closes flat and in line. One eye cracked and reglued.

Spoon in good order.

Salt - cover fits well. Both eyes appear to have been reglued with some glue residue visible. One eye has small pinhead size hole to centre.

Pepper - cover fits well. One eye missing, otherwise all good.
