### Condition Report

2200. Both plates have an overall light ageing, one with heavier distressing to two rectangular areas on the lower half. The frames are generally in very good order with only some minor wear and small knocks to the gilt surface. There are the usual thin cracks to the surface of the gilt in certain places and some visible but minor repairs to the reverse.
