A fine 19th century Egyptianesque mahogany console table, the blue veined marble top above a finely carved frieze and a pair of spiral moulded and stop fluted columns, united by a platform base, height 83cm, width 112cm, depth 36cm.

Condition Report

2001. The top has numerous chips to the edges and corners, particularly the two rear corners, some having been coloured with a blue paint. An old repair to the front edge. The rear left side pilaster capital is missing and there are some chips to the edge of the rear surround. The lower edges of the plinth have some chips to the veneer, mainly to the sides. Otherwise in the condition you would expect it to be having come straight out of an elderly private vendor's estate, with overall dust and surface dirt, and overall deep original patina.
