A good George III mahogany drum-top library table, the tooled brown leather top above drawers and dummy drawers, raised on moulded downswept legs and castors, height 77.5cm, diameter 109cm.

Condition Report

2005. The leather, as can be seen, has typical scuffs, as well as numerous brown stains. The frieze has a few small sections of replaced veneer and a few very minor areas of raised veneer. The top is fixed with a peg within the centre of the drum top. It rotates well and is structurally sound. The base appears to be original and in good condition. The handles have been replaced with clearly visible previous holes to the insides of the drawer. There is one slightly raised crack to the joint of the lower beading on the frieze.
