An early 20th century rosewood cased boudoir grand piano by Bluthner, circa 1909, serial number '80849', raised on fluted tapering legs and castors, height 99cm, length 198cm, width 132cm. Note: a non-transferrable ivory exemption certificate has been granted for the sale of this item.

Condition Report

2233. The piano appears to have been well looked after and has a clean looking interior, probably having had a relatively recent overhaul of the mechanism. It plays well, but will clearly need a tune when placed somewhere.

The case is also in generally good order, but does have some minor scuffs to corners and some fading, leaving a darker area where the hinged top has covered the other part of the lid. One key has lost a section of veneer, but the rear section and not the finger area.
