A pair of late 18th century French silver candlesticks, each with detachable nozzle above an urn shaped sconce and square tapering stem, each side of capital with a female bust, on a circular foot decorated with swans and roundels, various marks for Paris and maker's mark DG, total weight 814.8g, height 28.5cm.

### Condition Report

434. Candlestick 1 - generally good condition, typical surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage or repairs. Nozzle stuck in place by wax.

Candlestick 2 - dent to edge of circular base, but otherwise generally good condition, with typical surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage or repairs. Detachable nozzle with small dent to edge.
