Condition Report

1073. Generally good condition. The outer wood case is a little tatty and worn. Frame with some gapping at joints. The panel itself appears to be in generally good order with no significant damage or repairs. All stone appear to be present, some minor areas of discolouration to gilt, but decoration generally good and vibrant.
