A Chinese blue and white porcelain bottle vase, Qing dynasty, the ovoid body and slightly tapered cylindrical neck painted with a dragon, vapours and flaming pearl above a leaping carp, unmarked, height 37cm (drilled hole to base, neck damage and some loss).

Condition Report

1021. Extensive damage to neck with some re-gluing and a missing section (approx 3cm x 5cm). Crack running down from neck into the body (approx 30cm long). Drilled hole near to base for use as a table lamp. Typical surface scratches and wear to glaze.
