A Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain plate, late 19th century, painted with panels of birds, insects and flowers reserved against a turquoise ground filled with flowers and scrolling tendrils, diameter 25.2cm (minor rim chips), together with two Canton famille rose vases, late 19th century, painted with birds and flowers against turquoise and yellow grounds, height 15.2cm (minor faults), and a crackle glazed brushwasher, painted with previous vessels, diameter 7cm.

1267. Plate - numerous small chips to rim, otherwise good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze and enamels. Decoration is bright and vibrant. No cracks or restoration.

Yellow vase - chip to underside of rim, otherwise ok with no cracks or repairs. Typical wear to gilt and enamels. Turquoise vase - 3 tiny chips to underside of rim, otherwise ok but with wear to gilt and typical light surface scratches to glaze.

Brushwasher - generally good condition, some light staining to glaze, typical wear to decoration.
