### LOT 1101

A group of four Chinese carved pale celadon jade pendants, late Qing dynasty and later, including one carved as a boy, height 5cm, another carved and pierced with a figure on horseback, length 5cm, and another in the form of two lingzhi fungi, length 5.8cm, together with a Chinese celadon jade elephant carving, length 4.5cm.

### Condition Report

1101. Boy - good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Good uniform colour. Weight - 33.2g.

Figure on horseback - good condition with tiny nick to bottom right corner but no significant damage or repairs. Weight excluding chain - 17.6g.

Lingzhi fungus - good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches. Weight excluding chain - 45.6g.

Seated boy - generally good condition, minor scuff to tip of hair but no significant damage or repairs. Weight - 30.4g.

Elephant - good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Weights - 62.6g.
