A Japanese Satsuma earthenware bowl by Kanzan, Meiji period, of circular form with shaped rim, the interior painted and gilt with a figural scene of gods and children, all beneath a border of red-capped cranes, the exterior with a band of dense flowers, gilt and black signature to base, diameter 15.5cm, together with a Satsuma earthenware vase, Meiji period, painted with figures, height 12.1cm.

### Condition Report

1003. Bowl is in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light crazing and typical light wear to gilt, slightly more pronounced on rim.

Vase - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light crazing and some wear to gilt and enamels. Small firing crack to inside of rim.
