A Victorian gold, ruby and diamond ring, mounted with a cushion shaped ruby between old cut diamond three stone sides, unmarked, weight 5.3g, ruby dimensions approx 8.5mm x 7mm x 3.75mm, ring size approx L, with a case.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

All the diamonds have some unexpected abrasion to their table facet edges. Perhaps a result of poor storage in the past.

Diamond gradings - average clarity VS2/SI1, colour J/K (diamond gradings are estimations, limited by the setting and for guidance only)

The ruby is believed to be natural. It does not fit snugly within its setting and does move slightly. It has typical abrasions to facet edges. There are one or two small inclusions, but otherwise when viewed with a 10x loupe appears to be a fairly clear stone.

A few of the claws overall are requiring re-tipping, particularly around the ruby.

Some slight wear to the sides of the mount, with some noticeable thinning to the back of the shank.

The gold is unmarked and untested.

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
