A gold and cornelian intaglio signet ring, designed as a lady wearing a crown above two crossed quills/feathers, indistinct mark, weight 9.2g, ring size approx N, with a case.

Estimate: £280 - £320

Condition Report

Some heavy overall abrasion to the intaglio. The definition to the lower half of the face is lost, the nose in particular.

Some unevenness to the collet setting, with some noticeable wear, minor losses.

The shank and shoulders are in fairly good condition, with typical light scratching/scuffing.

The gold mark is fairly rubbed, only the 'CT' is decipherable.

The gold is untested, but believed to be of higher grade.

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
