A Chinese 'clobbered' blue and white porcelain spirit bottle, Kangxi period and later, of barrel form, painted in underglaze blue with flowers and leafy stems, later embellished in red, green and gilt, height 14cm, together with a pair of 'clobbered' blue and white porcelain horseshoe dishes, lengths 16.2cm and 16.4cm (rim chips).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1030. Bottle - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical wear to enamels and gilt with more pronounced wear to gilt on rim and upper bands.

Both dishes in generally good order with minor nicks to corners and rims but nothing significant. Typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels and gilt.
