1195. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear, but decoration is still nice and crisp. Good clear mark to base. Minor separation at inner skin rim and exterior body, but nothing of any real significance and no actual damage. Fits nicely on wood stand which is also in good condition.
