## LOT 1258

A Chinese cloisonné bottle vase, 20th century, decorated with three shou medallions surrounded by bats on a gilt whorl-filled cream ground, height 22.8cm, together with a pair of Japanese cloisonné vases, Meiji period, of shouldered tapering form, decorated with pigeons, flowers and blossoming branches on a black ground, red maker's mark to bases, height 30.8cm (damaged and repairs).

## Condition Report

1258. Chinese vase - good condition, no significant damage or repairs, typical light surface scratches and some slight wear to gilt rim.

Japanese vase 1 - extensive damage to shoulder, neck and rim with some fairly unsightly repairs. Also vertical crack and some enamel loss to the left of pigeons, repaired chip to reverse and other hairlines.

Vase 2 - similarly numerous repaired chips and cracks but repairs are obvious and not very well done.
